

**13** Is anyone among you in trouble? Let them pray. Is anyone happy? Let them sing songs of praise. **14** Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. **15** And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven. **16** Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

**17** Elijah was a human being, even as we are. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years. **18** Again he prayed, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its crops.

**19** My brothers and sisters, if one of you should wander from the truth and someone should bring that person back, **20** remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of their way will save them from death and cover over a multitude of sins.

#### V. 13-18 Is anyone among you...

- There are a number of responses we could have to suffering
  - Trouble - Pray
  - Happy - Praise
  - Sick - intercede
    - Uses broad term for sickness and oil (v.14)
      - Heb 12:3
      - Luke 10:34
- Call the elders (v.15)
  - Anoint and pray
  - Healing
    - Physical
    - Spiritual
- To each other (v.16)
  - Same as above
  - Because of the effectiveness of a believers prayer
- Elijah was a human being...(v. 17-18)
  - Examples of prayer of a believer

- Jesus on Praying Luke 11:1-13
- One of you should wander (19-20)
  - Turns from error (20)
  - Covers a multitude of sins (20)
