

7 Then came the day of Unleavened Bread on which the Passover lamb had to be sacrificed. 8 Jesus sent Peter and John, saying, “Go and make preparations for us to eat the Passover.”

9 “Where do you want us to prepare for it?” they asked.

10 He replied, “As you enter the city, a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him to the house that he enters, 11 and say to the owner of the house, ‘The Teacher asks: Where is the guest room, where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?’ 12 He will show you a large room upstairs, all furnished. Make preparations there.”

13 They left and found things just as Jesus had told them. So they prepared the Passover.

14 When the hour came, Jesus and his apostles reclined at the table. 15 And he said to them, “I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. 16 For I tell you, I will not eat it again until it finds fulfillment in the kingdom of God.”

17 After taking the cup, he gave thanks and said, “Take this and divide it among you. 18 For I tell you I will not drink again from the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes.”

19 And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, “This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me.”

20 In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you.

V. 7-8 “Then came the day...”

- Unleavened Bread and Passover Lamb
 - Num 9:1-14 and Ex 12:3-4
- Make Preparations

V. 9-13 ...just as Jesus told them”


- Nothing outside Father’s plan
- A man carrying water (10)
- The Teacher asks and a guest room
- Prepared the passover (13)
 - Normally with family and closest neighbor
 - Formation of new Covenant Family
 - Lk 8:19-21 and 11:27-28

V. 14-16 “...desired to eat this Passover...before I suffer”

- Passover established in Ex 12
- Ties the meal to his suffering (15)
 - Says the Passover Seder is about him
 - John 6:53-59
- Fulfillment in Kingdom of God (16)
 - Messianic banquet at end of time
 - Lk 11:15 and 1 Cor 11:26, 1 Cor 5:7

V. 17-20 “he took the cup...he took the cup...new covenant

- Divides the wine and makes it about his Kingdom (17)
 - In the Seder taken four times
 - Vows his work in the last cup
- Breaks the unleavened bread and says its his body (18)
- Blesses the cup and says its the New Covenant (19)
 - Jeremiah 31: 31-34
 - Establishes the substitutionary atonement as himself
 - Romans 5:1-11
