

Phrase One – Luke 23:34

34 Jesus said, “Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.” And they divided up his clothes by casting lots.

Phrase Two – Luke 23:43

43 Jesus answered him, “Truly I tell you, today you will be with me in paradise.”

Phrase Three – John 19:26

26 When Jesus saw his mother there, and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to her, “Woman, here is your son,” **27** and to the disciple, “Here is your mother.”

Phrase Four – Matthew 27:46

46 About three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, “*Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?*” (which means “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?”).

Phrase Five – John 19:28

28 Later, knowing that everything had now been finished, and so that Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, “I am thirsty.”

Phrase Six – John 19:30

30 When he had received the drink, Jesus said, “It is finished.” With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

Phrase Seven – Luke 23:46

46 Jesus called out with a loud voice, “Father, into your hands I commit my spirit.” When he had said this, he breathed his last.

Phrase One - Forgive them...

- Context
 - Crucifixion between the criminals, mocking and lots (Lk 23:26-43)
 - Shows forgiveness as a model and unbelievers in “ignorance”(Acts 3:17; 13:27; 14:16; 17:30; 26:9)
 - Matt 5: 44-48
 - “But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you...”

Phrase Two – “...today you will be with me...”

- Mercy in the midst of judgment (Lk 23:40-43)
 - “Don’t you fear God...”?

Phrase Three – “...here is your mother”

- Cares for his mother
- Makes a new family
 - Brought into his house (Lk 23:27)

Phrase Four – “Why have you forsaken me?”

- Preserves the Hebrew wording
 - Psalm 22:1

Phrase Five – I am Thirsty

- The drink would have prolonged his life and pain
- After tasting it he refused to drink more (Matt 27:34)
- Psalm 22:15

Phrase Six – It is finished

- Accomplished
- Paid in full
- The Prophecy fulfilled.

Phrase Seven – “...in to your hands...”

- Psalm 31:5
